Description

The fund seeks to maximize medium term returns by investing primarily in Dolar-denominated Brazilian Corporate and Government bonds issued abroad that comply with the criteria outlined in Article 8 of the SFDR. Investment approach based on robust credit research, market and macro monitoring and duration analysis.

Investment Objective

To obtain a superior return in the medium and long term, by investing mainly in the Brazilian debt market. Investments will be made based on risk and interest yield curve analysis, as well as fundamental credit research on the corporate and public issuers.

Investment Policy

Diversified portfolio invested in the Brazilian debt market, such as Brazilian Eurobonds issued by Brazilian Corporations in the international markets as well as in Brazilian Global Bonds issued by the Brazilian National Treasury abroad, both in USD or in any other foreign currency.

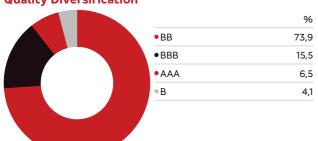

Manager's Comments

Review

During the third quarter, the fixed income and credit markets remained volatile, whether due to geopolitical risks from Russia-Ukraine or the Middle East, while there is still concern about stronger data in the US market. With less pressured inflation data, we saw an intense movement in Treasuries, extending the cycle of interest rate cuts, and thus we saw a tightening in rates for the year. In Brazil, the Central Bank concluded its monetary easing cycle, leading to significant market deterioration due to fiscal issues and unhelpful political rhetoric. The situation has been further exacerbated by an unfavorable external environment. The currency continues to depreciate in 2024 and has already lost 15% against the USD.

Positioning

The external issuance market began robustly in 2024, with recent issuances from Petrobras, Eletrobras, and Raizen, as well as new issuers such as Oceânica and LD Celulose. Issuances with strong demand highlight a market in need of new bonds. Brazil's five-year CDS ended last year at 130 basis points (bps), operated at a stable level for a long time, and has worsened this year, reaching a range of 150 bps. The portfolio manager decided to continue a more active management approach with Treasuries for portfolio duration optimization and tactical opportunities. The duration of the bonds was kept below the historical level of four years, a factor that generated alpha. In the quarter, the fund returned +4.99%.

Outlook

The portfolio continues to offer an attractive average yield relative to its risks. However, the shorter duration has been a factor in reducing alpha throughout this year. Since initiating our duration reduction in mid-2022 due to market opportunities, we have remained cautious and operated accordingly. We maintain a careful "bottom-up" analysis approach in our search for new investments
